

TECHNICAL DATA SHEET Decking Oil

Issue 2 - October 2015

Description:

Cromar Decking Oil is specially designed to be used on timber decking to enhance the beauty of the wood, and to help protect against drying and splitting. It also helps protect against water penetration which can cause warping and swelling.

Cromar Decking Oil should be dry within 24 hours of application.

It can be used on all types of decking including pre-treated, pressure treated or preservative-impregnated timber.

It is available in Clear, Cedar, Oak and Pine shades to match or alter the colour of your decking.

Preparation:

Decking timber must be free from dust, dirt mildew mould and other contaminants. To achieve this, a thorough washing with Cromar Decking Cleaner is recommended. Allow decking to dry thoroughly before continuing.

Application:

Do not apply in wet conditions, or if rain or frost are expected before the product is dry. Ensure that the cap is firm and shake container vigorously to thoroughly mix contents. Do not dilute. Apply to the prepared surface two liberal coats of Cromar Decking Oil (chosen colour) by brush or roller, ensuring saturation of joints and end grain. Allow to become touch-dry between coats. (Approx 2-4 hours depending on ambient temperature) Decking should be dry and ready for use after 24 hours.

N.B: Please note that the final colour, when dry, will depend on the type of wood to which it is applied and whether any previous application of coloured preservative has been made. In such instances, we recommend a test area to ensure that the finished result is acceptable.

Container Sizes: 5, 25

Coverage Rates: This is greatly dependent on the type of timber being treated, but as a rough guide coverage will

be 4 to 6m² per litre for each coat.

Cleaning: Brushes etc. can be cleaned with White Spirit followed by detergent.

Storage Conditions: Containers should be stored out of direct sunlight in dry conditions away from sources of ignition.

They should be stored undercover below a temperature of 35°C.
